

LEAD VOCALS 2015 CHARDONNAY

LEAD VOCALS NOT JUST A GREAT VOICE, BUT ALSO A GREAT PERFORMER. THE SHALE AND SANDSTONE ALLUVIUM FOUND IN BIEN NACIDO'S I BLOCK PROVIDE THE POTENTIAL FOR CHARDONNAY WITH BRIGHT ACIDITY, MINERALITY, AND LASTING FINISH. THE GENTLE SUR LIE AGING MAKES THIS WINE A SHOWSTOPPER.

AVA AND VINTAGE NOTES

Bien Nacido Vineyard's south facing 'bench' was originally planted in 1973. The wide spacing and consistently high quality in the 'l' block warranted a new set of interplants in the late 1990's and this wine comes from a combination of the old and new vines. The 2012 vintage was textbook with healthy yields and consistent weather during much of the growing season and all the way through harvest.

TASTING NOTES

Light golden, the 2015 Lead Vocals Chardonnay exhibits youthful vibrancy on the nose. Notes of white flowers and citrus lead to intense minerality. Fresh on the palate, with Lemon juice, honey, and a bit of saltiness this wine finishes with notes of Marzipan.
