Founded by Joshua Klapper, TIMBRE WINERY is the culmination of years of hard work, and dedication to our craft. It is winemaking expressed through the universal language of musical sound.

AVA AND VINTAGE NOTES

When we opened our tasting room in Arroyo Grande in 2017 a connection to the local wine community blossomed. We quickly became friends with the owners and farmers of great local Pinot Noir vineyards. The result is the house band, grown by locals, and made for locals.

TASTING NOTES

The color ranges between burgundy, garnet, rust, and auburn depending on the angle you stare through it. The aromas coming from this wine include cola, potpourri, strawberry, and dried black cherry. Earthy flavors co-mingle with pomegranate, cranberry, pine nuts, and a salty minerality.
