AVA AND VINTAGE NOTES

We have been sourcing Pinot Noir and Chardonnay from Riverbench for nearly 10 years, and 2020 was the first we had heard of the Albarino which has been growing there for quite some time. It was originally planted for Kenneth Volk, and for a time it was exclusive to him. When a small amount became available in 2020 we jumped at the chance to work with this crisp, floral variety, and the inherent quality of Riverbench vineyard was again apparent with this delicious wine!

TASTING NOTES

This wine has the color of a white nectarine. The extremely floral nose has hints of stone fruit, jasmine, and honeysuckle. Crisp on the tongue it is bright yet soft, and follows the nose with peaches and cream and confectioners sugar.
