AVA AND VINTAGE NOTES

We have been sourcing Pinot Noir and Chardonnay from Riverbench for nearly 10 years, and 2020 was the first we had heard of the Albarino which has been growing there for quite some time. It was originally planted for Kenneth Volk, and for a time it was exclusive to him. The 2021 is our second chance to work with this amazing fruit which has a gain resulted in a fresh, aromatic, and complex wine.

TASTING NOTES

This wine is the bomb! Super fresh with aromas of summer melon, green apple, nectarine, lime, and grapefruit, and even candy notes like banana runts! Citrusy acidity helps frame and the palate which also has tropical and creamy notes.
