Hailing from the Pali Vineyard in the Sta. Rita Hills in Western Santa Barbara County this vineyard ROOOOCKS! Cool climate, ancient marine soils, and killer farming combine to create a perfect storm for vibrant wines with beautiful tension. Open a bottle and you will see!

TASTING NOTES

Bright red, the nose on this wine is fruity, with red berry, potpourri, and a perfumed quality I find in my favorite Pinot Noirs. Pali is structured on the palate, always more cranberry than strawberry. This far western Sta. Rita Hills sight really screams crunchy acid and grippy tannin. Ripe, heavy, and serious, with a crazy long finish are some of my notes.
