## **AVA AND VINTAGE NOTES**

We have been sourcing Pinot Noir and Chardonnay from Riverbench for nearly 10 years, and 2022 was the first we had heard of the Albarino which has been growing there for quite some time. It was originally planted for Kenneth Volk, and for a time it was exclusive to him. The 2023 is our third chance to work with this amazing fruit which has a gain resulted in a fresh, aromatic, and complex wine.

## **TASTING NOTES**

Pale green with almost tropical aromas, summer melon, and citrus. The palate is dry, with lean, structured flavors, and leaning more lime than lemon. The clean finish makes this a natural accompaniment to almost everything on the table!
