DEAR FRIENDS

It has certainly been a **CRAZY START TO 2023**... The rains which started at the close of 2022 and into January were absolutely devastating to so many in our community. As an optimist, I have to say that the rain was almost universally regarded as helpful to our local vineyards. Grape vines are dormant this time of year, and as such, the water does not really affect the plants. Heavy **RAIN** is helpful because it helps to **FLUSH THE SOIL** which builds up irrigation salts in drought years. These salts bind to, and ultimately clog the vine root systems which then causes the vines to have trouble taking up nutrients from the soil. We should see very healthy growth this year... look for the vineyards to look super green, with a lot of vigorous growth throughout late spring and summer. Additionally, the standing water we see in our area should, over time, filter into our aquifers helping to replenish them for future vintages. Sadly, the rain kept people from going out (and worse), and we missed many of you in the month of January. Come see us soon!

THE SOMMELIER IN ME HAD TO TURN THIS RELEASE INTO A DINNER!

Aperitif- 2021 Opening Act Albariño, with tray passed tuna tartare and homemade baguette toast points. First course- 2021 Rare Groove #3 Sauvignon Blanc with a golden beet and goat cheese salad, lemon vinaigrette. Second Course- 2014 Lead Vocals Chardonnay, paired with lobster risotto... mmm.

Third Course- 2020 Rhythm and Guest Star Pinot Noirs side by side with grilled hangar steak with a red wine/shallot reduction and pomme puree (aka mashed potatoes with ridiculous amounts of butter. Like, a lot more that you think!). Cheese Course - Rare Groove #2 blend of Syrah and Grenache. with a selection of hard cheeses.

Dessert- Klapper's Poached pears with the 2013 Late Harvest Viognier. It's 10 years old this year and ridonculous!

2021 OPENING ACT ALBARIÑO, RIVERBENCH VINEYARD

This wine is the bomb! Super fresh with aromas of summer melon, green apple, nectarine, lime, and grapefruit, and even candy notes like banana runts! Citrusy acidity helps frame and the palate which also has tropical and creamy notes. Shake your rump, *The Beastie Boys*. Drink Now!

2021 RARE GROOVE #3 SAUVIGNON BLANC, MESA VERDE VINEYARD

Classic Sauvignon Blanc with citrus notes of lime and Meyer lemon, stone fruit, green apple, pear, and just a hint of freshly cut grass. The same flavors adorn the palate, which is bright and lively, but also has hints of dried papaya, golden fig, and sour watermelon. Listen to **So fresh and so clean**, *OutKast*. Drink Now!

2014 LEAD VOCALS CHARDONNAY, BIEN NACIDO VINEYARD

A re-release from our library, here is a sample of our notes from 2014: "Caramel, marzipan, lemon preserves, and a hint of grass. The zingy lemon and grapefruit create a harmonious wine so any musical pairings have to be harmony-heavy. Try Scarborough Fair by Simon & Garfunkel. Drink now-2025+ (Backstage Pass only).

2020 THE RHYTHM PINOT NOIR, RIVERBENCH VINEYARD

Scarlet, deep, ripe strawberry, with notes of flowers and savory herbs. The palate has blackberry, hibiscus, cranberry, and a touch of framing astringency. It finishes long with plum, raspberry, and orange peel and deliciously smooth tannins. Listen to **Flowers** by *Miley Cyrus*. Drink Now-2028+.

2020 GUEST STAR PINOT NOIR. GOLD COAST VINEYARD

Beautifully garnet and slightly opaque this wine exhibits hints of cranberry, spice, and sweet citrus. The first sip is fruity with pomegranate, cola, dates, and ruby red grapefruit. The finish is soft, very long and framed by refreshing acidity and cherry. How about some **Gold**, by *Dierks Bentley*. Drink Now-2028+.

2019 RARE GROOVE #2 RED BLEND. JOHN SEBASTIANO VINEYARD

This wine looks like the color of Concord grape jelly. The nose exhibits Fresno chilies, blackberry, sweet toasty oak, and orchids. The wine is bright and sublimely textured, velvety almost, with blueberry cobbler, and a plump, juiciness. It finishes with vanilla, plum, cherry, black pepper, and a warmth of sandalwood. Ummm... You're The One That I Want, from *Grease*, by *John Travolta* and *Olivia Newton John*. Drink Now-2030+.
